Proposal Elements

Each submission must, at a minimum, include:

1. General Background of the consultant / his or her firm, and the name(s), credentials of creative team members
2. A one-page narrative outlining the firm's strengths and distinguishing skills and/or capabilities
3. A representative selection of previous work

4. Names of current and past clients
5. General overview of your approach to the proposed work
6. Evaluation Criteria

The successful respondent will:

- Have a minimum of 2 years experience as a curriculum consultant
- Possess full-service capabilities for the tasks outlined
- Have the competitive cost of services
- Have expertise working with similar clients and projects
- Describe an approach that satisfies PPS expectations

Budget
